2. School uniform consists of:

Girls

Or Blue sweatshirt (with school logo)
Navy or black skirt or trousers
Summer – blue/white gingham dresses
& cardigans with school logo

Boys

White Polo Shirt (with school logo)
or Blue sweat shirt (with school logo)
navy or black trousers

3. School uniform can be purchased from the school office
4. Track suit bottoms with stripes down the sides and jeans are not allowed
5. A PE kit consisting of navy shorts and a white polo shirt with school logo has been purchased for each child and is to be kept in school.
